



Establish a Permanent Ranch & Healing Campus



Our goal is to develop a full-time ranch property that serves as a yearround refuge for girls and women recovering from trauma and exploitation. The ranch will feature:

- Horse and livestock facilities
- Healing trails and wilderness spaces
- Bunkhouses or tiny cabins for housing
- A chapel and outdoor worship areas
- Community garden and sustainable food sources
- Counseling, mentorship, and learning spaces

Expand Rehabilitation & Residential Programs

We plan to open a safe, faithcentered residential program for survivors of sex trafficking and exploitation by offering long-term support, job training, education, and spiritual development in a protected, nurturing environment.

Create Sustainable Funding Streams

We see a future where young women, especially those who've walked through our healing programs, become leaders themselves. Our academy will equip them to serve, speak, guide others, and live out bold faith and purpose.

Become a National Leader in Outdoor-Based Healing

Through our programs, curriculum, and founder-led speaking engagements, we aim to lead a national movement that brings outdoor healing, faith, and trauma recovery together. We envision chapters or sister programs across multiple states.

Ultimately, we envision The Light Ranch as a legacy—a place where the broken find healing, where girls rise up with confidence, and where God's love is seen in every detail. A beacon of hope for those walking through darkness.
